S/African killed in battle against B/Haram

A private South African para-military
specialist has been killed in an attack by
Boko Haram.

Former Koevoet member Leon Lotz,
of KwaZulu-Natal, is among scores of
former South African security force
personnel helping to train government
and allied forces to fight the insurgents.

The group of which Lotz was a
member is believed to be contracted to
the Nigerian government. It does not
have the support of the South African
government.

Lotz and five others, including
another foreigner and four Nigerian
soldiers, were killed on Monday near
