Our reporter learnt that the two injured victims were taken to a hospital at Koton-Karfe town, while the corpses of the dead ones were deposited at Federal Medical Centre in Lokoja.

Effort to get the reaction of the Konton-Karfe unit commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) over the incident was not successful but an official at the unit confirmed the accident

In another incident, three persons were injured in a motor accident which occurred Sunday evening,, near Sabon-Gari village, on the Abuja-Lokoja express way.

A witness said the accident happened around 5:23 p.m. when a Toyota Camry car with registration number XH 539 ABC had its tyre punctured while on top speed.

He said the car somersaulted before it crashed into a ditch, adding that the injured victims were taken to Kwali General Hospital.

When contacted, Yangoji unit commander of the FRSC, Assistant Corps commander, Jeremiah M. Fada, confirmed the accident.
