

Final year student crushed to death at Dutse

A final year undergraduate student was crushed to death on Sunday evening by a speeding vehicle along Dutse-Gwarinpa expressway.

A witness said the accident happened around 6:30p.m. when the deceased was crossing the ever busy expressway.

"The man was crossing the road when the driver of the car suddenly knocked him down, killing him on the spot," he said.

According to him, the driver ran

away immediately, while the corpse was immediately moved to the Kubwa General hospital.

City News learnt that the mother of the deceased could not hold herself when the news of her son's death got to her having spoken to him some minutes earlier before he met his untimely death.

In another case, two cyclists and a woman sustained varying degrees of injuries after a head-on collision along Dutse road in Bwari Area Council.

A witness said one of the cyclist was carrying

the woman when the other who drove against traffic hit him, adding that the three of them fell down and were serious injured.

He said they were later taken to the Kubwa General Hospital for treatment.

When contacted, the head of the Accident and Emergency Unit of the hospital, Paul Olise said the deceased was brought by the police and had been deposited in the hospital mortuary after being certified dead.

He said the three persons involved in the other accident are receiving treatment at the hospital.
