Three persons including a Policeman reportedly lost their lives in different parts of Rivers State yesterday. The corpse of the policeman was found at the Borokiri axis of Port Harcourt.

No explanation could be given on what was responsible for the death but a close look on the deceased showed that he had scares all over his body suggesting he was a victim of assassination.

The second victim was shot and beheaded at Buguma in Asari-Torlu LGA of the state on the alleged orders of a top politician from a leading political party in the state while the third victim, a youth corps member was reportedly shot by unknown gunmen.

The beheading of the young man who was said to be a strong supporter of the APC sparked off violent protest in the area which led not burning down of INEC and PDP offices in Buguma as at the time of filling this report.

Elections were yet to be concluded in some polling units while that of Akpor kingdom in Obio Akpor LGA was postponed for Sunday as at press time.
