1 killed in petrol station attack

One person was killed Tuesday when a group of six persons attacked a mobile fuel station in Wholshe, Jos-South Local Government Area of Plateau State.

Daily Trust gathered that the attackers besieged the petrol station while motorists were on the queue for fuel. A witness said the attackers which included three men and three women forced their way in, stoning and chasing people out of the station.

The motive behind the attack which led to the death of one James Daniel, an attendant is yet to be ascertained as the attackers did not take anything.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Emmanuel Abu, who confirmed the incident, said six persons have been arrested over the attack.

DSP Abu said: "The attackers went to the mobile petrol station under the guise of buying fuel but ended up stoning some persons including an attendant. The attendant was rushed to the hospital but he died while receiving treatment."
