7 terrorists' camps destroyed, many rescued —DHQ

The Defence Headquarters yesterday said seven additional terrorists' camps were destroyed as more terrorists were killed in the ongoing fight to flush them out of Sambisa forest.

A statement by Defence spokesman Major General Chris Olukolade said: "An additional 25 women and children were rescued in the process."

He added that: "troops who scaled series of land mines in continuation of the assault on the forest bases of the terrorists, captured camps which include the four notorious Alafa camps as well as those in Rogo Fulani, Laraga and others used as training camps in the forest.

"Various weapons including Rocket Propelled Grenades, Anti-Aircraft Guns and a number of vehicles were either captured or destroyed during the operation. Four soldiers were wounded and have been evacuated for treatment," Olukolade said.
