Family seeks justice for man's killing

The family of one Samaila
Adamu who was killed by
people said to be vigilante
members that claimed to have
caught him trying to steal cows
in Igabi LGA of Kaduna State
has called for justice.

His brother, Jafar Y. Mugero, said in an interview that Samaila went for a wedding in Igabi on May 2, 2015 and never returned.

"My brother went for a wedding on Friday May 1 to his friend, Zakari's house for a wedding on May 2. It was around 8am next day that we were told that one Abdul who resides in Jaji, shot him to death and took his corpse to the police in Rigachikun.

He said when they went

to the police station, it was confirmed that the body was there, but the police refused to release it to them. He said his late brother had three pregnant wives and seven children.

Police spokesman, DSP
Zubairu Abubakar, said the
police had arrested Abdul
and two others who claimed
to be vigilante members in
connection with the case.
The Commissioner of Police
has seen the complaint letter
and asked for the transfer of
the case to the CID|, he said.
Abubakar said the police could
not release the corpse because
the cause of death had to be
ascertained by a professional
before release.
