2 One dies, six cars damaged as truck crashes into fuel queue

One person lost his life while six cars were damaged in a multiple accident that occurred recently at the NNPC mega filling station along Abuja-Kubwa expressway.

A witness said the accident happened around 2p.m. when an articulated trailer coming from the Abuja axis lost control and crashed into a long queue of vehicles at the NNPC mega station.

He said about six cars along the service lane of the expressway were damaged while the driver in one of the vehicles died on the spot.

The witness, who blamed the accident on the persistent fuel scarcity across the country, said it affected such number of vehicles as the entire service lane was completely blocked by cars.

The Kubwa Divisional Police Officer, Chief Superintendent Nurrudeen Sabo, who confirmed the accident, said his men were immediately deployed to assist other security personnel in clearing the overwhelming heavy traffic jam along the expressway caused by the accident.
