Gunmen kill 13 in Benue market, seize Rep-elect's mum

Gunmen Wednesday killed 13
people in a village market in
Ukum LGA of Benue State, while
another set abducted the mother
of a House of Representatives
member elect same day in
Buruku LGA.

Daily Trust gathered that

market, a border town between Benue and Taraba States.

They began shooting after a failed attempt on their target and in the end, 13 people laid dead while many others sustained injuries.

Majority leader of the state House of Assembly, Paul Biam

who represents the area, told newsmen in Makurdi yesterday that 13 people fell in the shooting.

However, spokesman of the police command, ASP. Austin Ezeani, said three people died while five were responding to treatment in an undisclosed hospital.

Elsewhere in Benue, Mrs.

Mwuese Jev, the 73-year-old mother of member-elect House of Representatives for Buruku Federal constituency, Orker Jev, was abducted by another set of gunmen at about 8pm from her home in Tombo village of Buruku LGA Wednesday. The woman, according to her son, Orker, was whisked away by

some terrific gunmen. Orker said his mother's whereabouts had not been established as the kidnappers had yet to make any demand for ransom.

Police spokesman, ASP Austin Ezeani, said the kidnappers drove in a red Toyota Camry car in which the woman was taken away.
