7 drown in Bauchi

The Bauchi State Police Command said yesterday that seven people drowned in the state between June and now.

The state Police Public Relations Officer of the command,

DSP Haruna Mohammed, in a statement said the development is a source of concern to the command.

Mohammed said: "Available statistics revealed that between 21/6/2015 and 12/8/2015, over five cases were reported from various locations across the state.

In total, seven people drowned. Three in River Yuguda, one in River Kirfi, one in Alkalari, one in Ganjuwa."

He advised members of the public, especially those who cannot swim to stay away from river bank/streams or open drainages.

The police spokesman urged parents to monitor and warn their children of the dangers involved in going into the river/streams.

He assured members of the public of the command's commitment to secure lives and property.
