Man set ablaze for vandalising vehicle




A man who was alleged to have attempted to remove the brain box of a vehicle parked along Isikalu Street in Ajegunle, Apapa area of Lagos was early yesterday set ablaze by a mob.

The suspect was arrested by some vigilantes in the area while he was allegedly carrying out the act at about 3am.

"They gave him the beating of his life before putting a used tyre around his neck and setting him on fire," he added.

Policemen from the Trinity Police Station were at the scene yesterday trending stories before council officials arrived to remove the mutilated corpse.
