Gunmen kill 2 farmers, injure 12 others in Taraba

The Taraba State Police Command said on Saturday in Jalingo that unidentified gunmen shot dead two farmers in Kortse village in Gassol Local Government Area.

Mr Joseph Kwaji, the Police Public Relations Officer, told newsmen that dozen others were injured in the attack.

He said the gunmen also attacked six families, who were fishing in Kortse village, near Dan-Anacha, killed two persons, while others ran for their lives.

He said when news of the attack got to the police, they combed the area but could not arrest any suspect.

Kwaji said remains of the deceased were recovered and handed over to their families for burial.

It was gathered that the victims were displaced persons, who had just returned home after previous deadly attacks in the area.

It was the third time in two weeks that returnees were attacked by unidentified gunmen. (NAN)
