Biz man shot dead at computer village

An unidentified businessman was yesterday shot dead by a two-man robbery gang who operated on a motor bike at the Computer Village, Ikeja, Lagos.

The robbers shot him twice and went away with his black nylon bag containing some money. His body was still lying by the foot of the bridge along Obafemi Awolowo Way, Ikeja at the time of filing this report yesterday.

A commercial bus operator who witnessed the incident, Femi Olaolu, told Daily Trust that the robbers shot him at close range.

"It was raining and the man was walking towards the Computer Village. He was walking by the side of the bridge, but it was like he was being trailed by the gang on a bike. The one at the back of the bike shot him while the other riding the bike grabbed the black nylon bag he was holding and they zoomed off. I guess they trailed him from the bank," he said.
