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Barber held for killing friend over noodles

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A 25 year-old barber, Oluwaseun Ojo, has been remanded at Olokuta prison in Akure by an Akure Chief Magistrates' Court for allegedly killing his friend, Shola Omotayo over noodles.

He was alleged to have stabbed the friend and roommate with a broken bottle during an argument over the noodles.

Magistrate Sunday Adedapo ordered the remand pending the receipt of legal advice from the state's Director of Public Prosecution.

Police prosecutor, ASP Pelumi Adejuwon, told the court that Oluwaseun stabbed Shola on the chest and back while arguing over the noodles cooked by the deceased.

They had lived together in the same room at No.10 Familusi Gaga Area of Oke-Aro, Akure before the killing.

The plea of the counsel, Mrs Obanigba Grace, was not taken by the court while the case was adjourned till Nov. 26 for legal advice.

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
