Policeman kill woman in Kaduna

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A Mobil Policeman residing at the Mobil Police Barracks of Television area in Kaduna has allegedly shot a woman to death, Daily Trust has gathered.

The name of the policeman in the incident which occurred on Saturday afternoon could not be confirmed at the time of filing the report.

The woman was believed to be his ex-wife. It was however gathered that the policeman is an indigene of Bauchi State.

An eye witness who pleaded for anonymity said: "I was in the barracks for a wedding on that fateful day when the incident occurred. The woman had come to remove her things out of the policeman's house after he had divorced her when an argument ensued between them and he shot her."

When contacted, Public Relations Officer of St. Gerald hospital, Mr. Sunday John Ali confirmed that a 27-year old woman from Hong local government of Adamawa State, Safiya Abubakar was brought to the hospital at about 2.55pm on Saturday with two gunshot wounds.

He said the woman was brought to the hospital dead on arrival and was immediately deposited at the hospital mortuary.

Daily Trust had earlier contacted the Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Zubairu Abubakar claimed not to have any knowledge about the incident.

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
