300 level student killed over girlfriend in Jigawa

A 300 level student of Federal University, Dutse, Jigawa State, Bashir Musa was reported to have been killed in fight over a girl friend last Friday, Daily Trust gathered yesterday.

It was learnt that the trouble that led to the death of Musa began when his girlfriend, Aisha Sale, a student of Jigawa state Polytechnic who is befriending six others including the deceased, all from same university visited

one of her boyfriend in Yalwawa quarters of the state capital. A group of other five boyfriends that includes the deceased stormed the house of the other boyfriend of the girl whom she had visited and attacked him, leading to a

serious scuffle which resulted to the death of Musa.

In a statement issued over the incident by the University, the Registrar of the University, Yusuf Adamu said the university would make its position known to the public

after the police investigation.

Contacted, the state Police Command Spokesperson, DSP Abdul Jinjiri confirmed the incident saying investigation revealed that late Musa died after a scuffle with five others over a girl friend.
