



Police arrest 4 rustlers, recover cows in Yobe

The Yobe State Police Command has arrested four suspected rustlers and recovered six cows and 19 sheep at Garaji village, Tarmowa Local Government Area.

Parading the suspects, the Police Commissioner, Zanna

Ibrahim, said the four suspects stole and shared the animals among themselves. He added that the animals belonged to one Muhammed Abdul of Gareji village and that they are valued at N345,000.

"Police recovered six cows and 19 sheep. The suspects will soon be charged to court," he said.

The police commissioner who gave the names of the suspects as Buba Ibrahim, Usman Manga, Gidado Hassan and Ahmadu Buba, said they had been terrorising different parts of the North-east.

He warned that police would not spare anyone in the fight against rustling.

The commissioner also

paraded two farmers over the killing of a herdsman and injuring of another in Dapchi.

He said the deceased, Garba Jarima, led his herd into the farm of one Usman Abubakar and destroyed his crops.

He said the farmer and his father then trailed the herdsman and shot him to death.
