10 killed in Ebonyi auto crash

Ten people including a woman and her two kids were killed in an auto crash along the Afikpo-Abakaliki highway in Ebonyi State.

The crash occurred at a junction close to the motor park. It was gathered that those injured were shed to a hospital in Abakaliki for treatment, just as bodies of the deceased were deposited at the mortuary.

The accident occurred when an 18-seater bus belonging to Ezza-South Local Government Council with registration number, Ebonyi NKE 28LG,

rammed into a truck with registration number; DKA 17YE.

A witness, Mr Favour John, who spoke to our correspondent, said a lot of crashes occur at that junction.

He said the accident could not be linked to over speeding but impatience on the part of the bus driver.

The witness called on the state government to install bumps at the junction to check such incidents.

Another witness, Mr. Victor Ituma, said, "I was just coming out of my house when the incident occurred. The truck was making a turn when the bus

rammed into it. My annoyance was that why should a truck as big as that make a turn at such a busy junction? A traffic warden must be posted to that junction to direct people".

Reacting to the incident, Chairman of Ezza-South council, Joseph Egede shut down the mass transits bus unit in the area, adding that the drivers would have to attend a seminar before they resume work.

"They will also take a test and anyone who does not pass it will lose his job. We did not give them car keys to kill our people", he said.
