Bandits kill 20 in Zamfara village

Gunmen yesterday killed at least 20 people in a dawn attack on Mashema village in Bungudu LGA of Zamfara State.

Witnesses said dozens of gunmen arrived on motorbikes, firing at residents, warning those inside their houses to remain indoors and daring the vigilantes to come out and fight.

The state police spokesman, DSP Sanusi Amiru, said the attack might be a reprisal.

"It might be a retaliatory attack because nothing was taken by the assailants, they just shot residents dead and made away", he said.

Yesterday's attack came barely a week after four people were killed in a similar situation in Tangaran village of Anka LGA of the state.

The police spokesman said corpses of the victims were collected and autopsy was carried out on them before burial.

"Normalcy has returned to the area as a team of security personnel was dispatched to the community and the situation is under control", he added.
