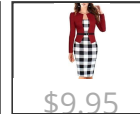

Boko Haram killed 14 in Borno village attack

No fewer than 14 people were, Friday night, killed and dozens injured when Boko Haram insurgents attacked a village near Biu in Borno State people that escaped from the attack said.

The insurgents, who stormed Kimba, a village in Biu Local Government Area on bicycles, attacked the village around 10:00pm,

killed at least 14 people, injured many and set the village ablaze. Alhaji Ali Biu, who escaped from the village, said many properties in the village were destroyed, adding: "When the sound of gun started roaring, people were running towards different directions, and then the insurgents carted away food items and property before setting the place ablaze."

Another resident of the area, Mamza Iliya, told this reporter on phone that most of the villagers that survived the attack were now at the IDP camp in Biu, appealing to the government to provide foods and relief materials to the affected people.

Iliya said for sometimes now, the camp in Biu was witnessing shortage of relief materials, adding: "In fact, some of the IDPs here are feeding themselves. Today (Saturday), many people have arrived from Kimba as a result of last night's attacked."
