2 killed in Kano car race, police nab 17

Kano State Police Command has paraded 17 suspects over illegal car racing stunts that resulted in the death of two people.

According to the state's

Police Public Relations Officer, Magaji Musa Majiya, a Chief Superintendent, the suspects were arrested when they blocked the busy Hadejia Road in the metropolis as they engaged in a dangerous car stunts racing that led to the death

of two people.

He added that the suspects arrested are the sons of some influential people in the community, adding that four cars were confiscated.

Majiya also gave the names of one Sulaiman Muhammad and Shahidu

Sani Musa as those that got killed as a result of the racing stunts.

"We have also confiscated four luxurious cars that include a Toyota Prado jeep, Peugeot 306, a Toyota and a Honda used during the stunts and we have also arrested

17 suspects who were sons and relatives of some very influential personalities within the community.

The Kano State Police Command will not leave any stone unturned in the cause of ongoing investigation into this case," Majiya said.
