

Police kill suspected robbers

The police in the Federal Capital Territory (FCT) on escort duty on the Zuba-Kaduna road, yesterday gunned down two suspected robbers.

A police source told our reporter that the security operatives engaged the suspected dare-devil armed

robbers in a fierce gun battle, shooting and fatally wounding two of them in the process. He added that others fled as they were overpowered.

Our source also hinted that three AK-47 rifles, 104 rounds of live ammunitions, one Toyota Corolla car with registration number, KSF 58 AJ, red colour and the sum of

N57, 130.00 were recovered from the suspected robbers.

"The area was thoroughly combed, but no arrest was made. The fatally wounded members of the robbery gang were confirmed dead at the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital (UATH) where they were taken for medical attention. Their corpses have been deposited at the

mortuary," he said.

When the police public relations officer, FCT command, Assistant Superintendent Anjuguri Manzah was contacted, he confirmed the incident and said the Criminal Intelligence and Investigation Department (CIID) of the command was investigating the incident.
