## Train crushes man, 25, to death

A train Wednesday night crushed to death, a man suspected to be a drug addict at the Sharada Quarters in Kano.

Twenty-five year-old Ahmed Adda'u Musa Mai-Kurdubi, a former student of Government Arabic Secondary School Gwale, was said to have had a drug overdose and slept on the rail track.

The train tore him into four parts and his remains were discovered by passersby early yesterday.

His father, Alaramma Adda'u Musa Mai-Kurdubi, said despite being a drug addict, he was still very helpful.

"He always assisted me in handling the affairs of the house. Of all my children, he was the only one that had this quality", he said, adding that Ahmed was lured into drug abuse by friends.

"Just yesterday, he told me about his plan to go back to school. He attended Government Arabic Secondary School Gwale and wanted to proceed to another school", he said.

A few hours after the incident, another drug addict went to the same rail track where Ahmed was crushed and sat on it. When our correspondent visited the scene yesterday, he was still there despite several attempts by passersby to persuade him to leave.
