

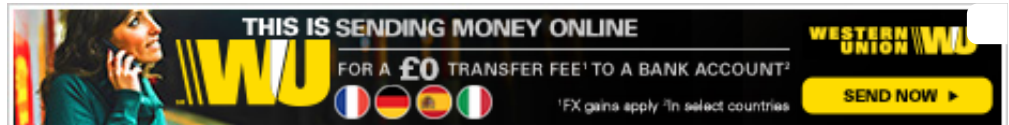

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20 killed in Rivers auto crash

Twenty people were feared killed yesterday when two vehicles collided along the East/West road near Mbiama in Ahoada West LGA of Rivers State.

An 18-seater passenger bus heading to Yenagoa from Port Harcourt collided with a truck coming from the opposite direction.

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Twenty persons inside the bus including the driver and the conductor were killed according to witnesses. The witnesses said the bus was cut into two and corpses littered the road. At the time of filing this report, efforts to reach the police command in the state were unsuccessful.



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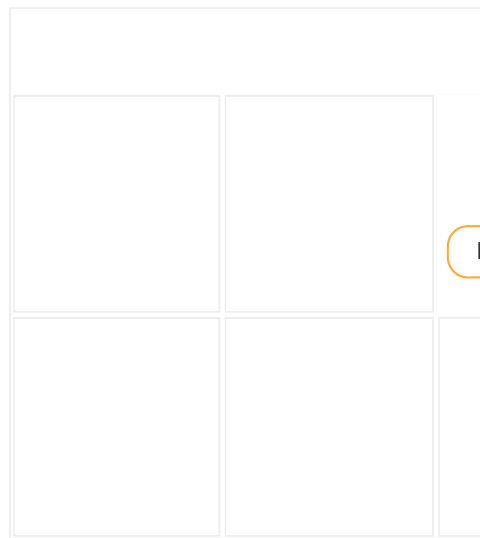
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
