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Agatu: 9 more corpses found, Ortom alleges fresh killings

Benue State Governor Samuel Ortom of yesterday said that more killings were going on in Agatu local government area of the state and that nine fresh dead bodies had been recovered.

Ortom made the disclosure while answering questions from newsmen

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shortly after inaugurating a committee on Renewable Energy and Energy Efficient project implementation at the Government House in Makurdi.

"At least nine people were killed on Monday. The commissioner of police went there and reported to me that he saw nine corpses," he said, adding that the attack on the Idoma Agatu speaking people was worrisome.

Meanwhile, the residents who deserted their areas in Agatu are still taking refuge in different parts of the state.

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
