Two persons were reportedly killed by officers of the Nigerian Customs Service (NCS) at Oke Odan in Yewa South Local government of the state on May Day.

The Customs Public Relations Officer (CPRO), Usman Abdullahi, who spoke with journalists yesterday in Abeokuta, confirmed the development. He however said those killed were suspected smugglers

Usman further stated that the smugglers, who blocked all the roads, also attacked and burnt four Customs check points.

The spokesman of the state Police command, Muyiwa Adejobi, also told newsmen at Iwe Irohin House of the Nigeria Union of Journalists (NUJ) secretariat, that two persons were killed and that one person was arrested.

An indigene of the area, Kayode Lateef Ajani alleged that seven persons, including two infants, were killed by stray bullets. The Federal lawmaker representing Ipokia/Yewa South Federal Constituency, Rep. Adekunle Akinlade, said in a press release, "The shooting of innocent bystanders is unfortunate and unacceptable. In light of this development, I have opened talks with the leadership of the security agency involved."
