Motorist kills okada rider in Kubwa

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A commercial motorcyclist was yesterday crushed by a motorist on the Abuja-Zuba expressway.

The accident, witnesses said, happened at 8pm, around the NNPC filling station, Kubwa second gate, involving a Volkswagen Vento car and the motorcyclist.

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One of the witnesses said the driver was heading towards Zuba from the city centre when he lost control and hit the victim from behind. He said the he fell off the motorcycle and hit his head on the road, sustaining severe injury. The driver of the vehicle was apprehended by the police.

The witness said the victim was taken to the Kubwa General Hospital by the police for medical attention.

City News, however, learnt that he died few minutes later while



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receiving treatment at the hospital due to excessive bleeding. Reacting, the Kubwa Divisional Police Officer (DPO), Chief Superintendent Nuruddeen Sabo, confirmed the death of the man, saying the remains had been deposited at the hospital morgue. He further said the vehicle involved in the accident was removed by the owner who arrived the scene shortly before the police came to impound it.

"Before my men could come back to impound the vehicle, the owner had already removed it, but efforts are on to track him through the information provided by the driver," he added.

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
