Gunmen kill 3 in Benue

Unknown gunmen at the weekend killed three people in two separate incidents in Benue state.

The state police spokesman ASP Moses Yamu who confirmed the incidents, said a man and his wife were shot dead by yet-to-be identified gunmen in Agasha area of Guma local government council while the other, a boy of 20 years, Friday Okoh, was killed by suspected cultists at North Bank in the capital metropolis, Makurdi.

Yamu said the killers of the man and his wife set the couple and their home ablaze before the police

arrived to recover empty shells of a rifle at the scene in Agasha, a community near Makurdi.

He said the mission of the killers against the couple could not be immediately ascertained but that the 20-year-old Okoh had been on the wanted list of the police on suspicion of cultism. He said it was the father of the boy who reported to the police that some young men armed with dangerous weapons stormed his residence in North Bank at 2pm on Saturday and shot his son.

The police spokesman said investigation had commenced into the matter.
