Armed robbers raid Lagos bank

Dare devil armed robbers yesterday raided Access Bank at Odun Ade market, killing one of the customers and carting away an undisclosed sum of money.

Though, three of the robbers were later nabbed by policemen from Ajegunle Police Station, a policemen attached to the bank and two others sustained varying degrees of injury.

The robbers, about six in number, arrived the bank on three motor bikes around 8.30am, pretending to be among the early morning customers.

It was gathered that the robbers opened fire on the deceased customer as soon as they sited him clutching onto a bag.

An eye witness alleged that the robbers pounced on the victim as soon as he fell and collected his black nylon bag said to contain an undisclosed amount.

In the ensuing confusion, the victim was left to bleed to death.

It was gathered that, as soon as the attack on the bank got to the Lagos State Commissioner of Police, Fatai Owoseni, he put all Area Commanders, Area B, Area C and Area E and their respective Divisional Police Officers on the alert, a step which led to the arrest of three of the robbers.
