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1 dies, stray bullet hits woman in Zaria

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One person yesterday lost his life while many others were injured in an inter-gang fight in the Kwarin Dangoma area of the ancient city of Zaria. Earlier, a 25-year-old woman was on Wednesday evening hit by a stray bullet in the Tudun Wada area of the city when police were struggling to clear hoodlums that stormed there.

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Daily Trust's investigation revealed that the woman, Maryam Abubakar, a mother of two, was at their family house in Layin Sarki, Tudun-Wada, Zaria for the Sallah celebration when the stray bullets hit her.

Maryam's husband, Malam Musa Bawa, told newsmen yesterday, "The incident happened on Wednesday evening about 6:00pm at my mother in-law's residence. They were in the house when policemen pursued some thugs who ran close to the house, only for those behind her to see the victim slump. As I am talking to you, four pints of blood have been transfused into her because she lost lots of blood before the doctors came to her rescue."

In a related development, thugs from different gangs yesterday clashed, leading to the death of one person, while many sustained injuries.

Daily Trust learnt that rival gangs from Tudun Wada and Kwarin Dangoma areas of the city were those involved in the fight. Residents said the gangs had been terrorizing the areas, especially during Sallah festivities.

"They usually come out for a killing spree. They don't differentiate; they attack anyone they come across," a resident said.

When contacted, the spokesperson of the Kaduna State Police Command, ASP Aliyu Usman, confirmed the incidents.



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
