4 soldiers die, 16 injured in Boko Haram blast

The Nigerian Army yesterday said an officer and three soldiers were killed after running into an Improvised Explosive Device and ambush by Boko Haram militants in Borno State.

He said the ambush was cleared and three Boko Haram militants were killed.

"Unfortunately, we lost an officer and three soldiers while 16 soldiers and three civilian JTF members sustained injuries during the encounter. Similarly, two vehicles that entered the IED were badly damaged," Usman said.
