

Suspected herders kill farmer in Benue

A man identified as Ejembi Amali was on Monday evening killed by suspected herders at Ogege in Edumoga district of Okpokwu local government area in Benue State.

Daily Trust gathered that the deceased was murdered at his farm allegedly by the herders after a misunderstanding broke out between them and some farmers.

It was learnt that the

incident caused residents of the Idoma speaking village to flee their homes.

The Benue State Police Command Public Relations Officer, ASP Moses Yamu who confirmed the incident said about 5pm on Monday, the herders and farmers had a rift in Ogege village in Okpokwu LGA, and that by the time the Police mobilised to the place, one man whose name was given as Ejembi was discovered to have been killed ostensibly by the herders.
