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Petrol tanker crushes 5 in A/Ibom

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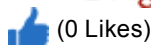
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Five people lost their lives yesterday in an accident involving a petrol tanker and a tricycle along Uyo-Calabar Highway in Obong Itam, Uyo, Akwa Ibom State.

Our correspondent gathered that the driver of the tanker was trying to escape from the police who were stopping him for driving on one headlamp, and in the process of running away hit a tricycle and then crashed into a pavement before catching fire.

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All the passengers in the tricycle were male and died in the incident. When contacted, the Public Relations Officer (PRO) of the Akwa Ibom State Command of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Mr. Godsgift Uwen, confirmed the incident and the number of persons killed.



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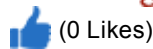
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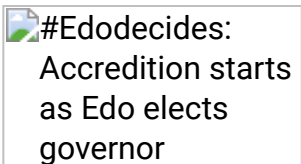
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
