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Troops nab suspected Boko Haram militant

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A suspected Boko Haram militant, Adamu Nuhu, was arrested by troops on Sunday at Kwaya Kusar Local Government Area in northern Borno, Army spokesman, Col. Sani Usman, said yesterday.

Usman said the arrest followed a tip off, adding that Nuhu is currently being interrogated.



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"Similarly, at about 5.43 p.m. Sunday, three women suspected to be spouses of wanted Boko Haram terrorists and logistics suppliers were arrested at Miringa market by vigilante members in the town," Usman said. He added the vigilante members had handed the women to troops and were also being investigated.

In a related development, Usman said troops of the 33 Brigade, Nigerian Army, deployed at Forward Operation Base (FOB), Bauchi, killed five suspected kidnappers at Dutsen Makurd in Ningi Local Government Area. He said the killing followed an exchange of gunfire between the suspects and troops.

According to the army spokesman, three dane guns and other dangerous weapons were recovered from the suspects. (NAN)



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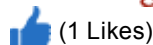
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
