

2 dead, dozen missing after insurgents attack Borno village

At least two villagers have been killed and a dozen others abducted when insurgents attacked a village in Askira/Uba local government area of Borno State on Monday, hunters and

A source said the insurgents came on motor bikes and camels to wreak havoc on civilians in Wasada village of Askira/Uba about 2:30pm on Monday and opened fire on villagers.

The source told *Daily Trust*

by phone that some vigilantes went to the area shortly after the attack but could not find any civilian except those who returned last night and this morning.

"Some lucky villagers who ran into bushes have been looking for their relations

since yesterday. 13 people are yet to return, including six women, two young girls and five males," local hunters said.

He added, "Our member called us from Wasada village for assistance. We responded but the terrorists succeeded in killing two and five civilians

were injured. Also they set ablaze the village and looted food items."

Civilian JTF sources disclosed that three women had returned while some of the victims were currently with their relations in Wamdeo village near Uba town.
