

## APC chieftain killed in Ondo

**T**he All Progressives Congress (APC) in Ondo State yesterday said thugs killed a chieftain of the party in Owo Local Government Area of the State, Mr Afolabi Olaposi, aka Arogun.

The party in a statement by its Publicity Secretary, Omo'ba Abayomi

Adesanya, said Olaposi was shot dead on his way home after a meeting of party chieftains.

According to him, the deceased was from Igboroko Ward one in Owo LGA. He was an ardent supporter of the party's candidate, Mr Rotimi Akeredolu.

The thugs also attacked the house of Chief Jamiu Ekungba, a BoT member of the APC and a governorship aspirant in

the September 3 party primary.

Similarly, some supporters of Olusegun Abraham, who came second in the primary election of the APC, those of Mr Isaac Kekemeke (the Ondo State APC leader) as well as supporters of the national leader of the party, Bola Ahmed Tinubu, alleged that they were attacked by members loyal to the governorship candidate of the party, Rotimi Akeredolu.
