Daily Trust on Sunday gathered that five other staff of the institution sustained various degrees of injuries.

Our correspondent learnt that the victims were on their way to Damaturu from Gashua town to write their promotion examination when the accident occurred around 8am.

One of the survivors, Maigari Kalka, said the driver, who died on the spot, was on speed when the rear tyre of the 18-seater bus burst and the car somersaulted.

Provost of the college, Alhaji Muhammad Gishiwari, confirmed the incident to *Daily Trust on Sunday*, saying that 14 people were involved in the accident.

He said nine people died while five others were receiving treatment at the General Hospital, Gashua.

"They were 14 in the car, four people died on the spot, while the remaining five died in the hospital. They set out very early to beat the exams time, not knowing that death was lurking in the corner. May their souls rest in peace," he said.

He said that the deceased had been buried in Gashua town, according to Islamic rites.



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
