Gunmen kill Arthur Eze's aide, injure others in Anambra

The gunmen, numbering about six, invaded the community about 11pm and also inflicted some other persons with gunshots.

When *Daily Trust* [VISITED](#) the residence of the deceased, his sister, Ijeoma Ikedimma lamented that her brother was returning from the neighbourhood without a premonition of the impending danger.

Sources said the killing might be connected to the ongoing communal battle between Abagana and Ukpo communities over a piece of land which had claimed scores of lives and property worth several millions of naira.

"Abagana people believe that our people working with Arthur Eze who hail from Ukpo and other prominent persons in that community might be giving them information on the plans Abagana people have on their tussle with Ukpo over a piece of land. So the option, as being speculated, was to 'address' their matter one by one," a source said.

The state Police Commissioner, Sam Okaula, said of the incident, "This is an isolated case. It is a case of murder somewhere in the village. The police are on it and must smoke out the culprits."

He said the incident had no connection with the land tussle between Ukpo and Abagana communities.
