Masari threatens trouble makers after 8 killed in fracas

Governor Aminu Bello
Masari of Katsina State
has vowed to deal with
anybody or group or
persons whose activities
pose serious threat to
peace in the society.

Masari, according to a
statement by his Senior
Special Assistant on
Media, Abdu Labaran,
took the stance when he
went on a sympathy visit
to Dungun Muazu town
where eight persons
were killed in a fracas
between farmers and
cattle herders.

Masari said his
administration was
determined to bring

lasting peace in the state
and there was no reason
why some criminals
would hold the society to
ransom.

"The government
has the resources, the
personnel, and the
willpower to deal with
the situation for good,"
he said, and cautioned
against blanket
judgment, specifying
that it was wrong to
regard all Fulani herders
as criminals

"No ethnic group has
the monopoly of virtue
or vice, it is therefore
wrong on the account of
the misdeeds of a few bad
elements to generalize
all members of the group
as criminals," he said.
