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Four men of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) and the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) have died after they were hit by a motorist in Zamfara

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Three of the deceased were FRSC men and one a personnel of the NSCDC.

The Zonal Commanding Officer (ZCO) of the FRSC in charge of Zone RS 10, Sokoto, Mrs Mary Wakawa who disclosed this in Sokoto, said the officers were part of a mobile court sitting at the time of the incident along the Sokoto-Gusau highway.

She said the late FRSC officials included Bello Lawal, Bello Abdullahi and Bashiru Ango, while the deceased NSCDC official was Bashir Yakubu.

Wakawa added that two others: Sgt. Haruna Ilyasu of the Nigeria Police and Abubakar Sodangi of the FRSC who were also involved in the incident, survived with [INJURIES](#).

She decried the attitude of some motorists towards obedience of traffic rules and stressed the need for collective efforts towards ensuring safety on the roads.



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
