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Miners clash: reprisal claims additional 4 in Plateau

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Four people are feared dead in a reprisal attack between illegal miners in Jos south and Bassa local government areas of Plateau State.

Six persons were confirmed killed by the Plateau State Commissioner of Police, Peter Ogonyanwo on Wednesday when miners from Gyel in Jos South and Miango in Bassa had a dispute that turned violent.

Operation Safe Haven Commander Major General Rogers Nicholas had visited the communities on Wednesday and appealed for calm.

However, suspected youths from Jos South were set to have crossed over to Bassa yesterday for a reprisal that saw the death of four persons.

OPSH Media and Information Officer, Captain Adam Umar told our correspondent that about 12 persons had been arrested over the incident and that calm had been restored.



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
