

Man, 21, found dead in well

A 21-year-old man identified as Aminu Ayuba, has been found dead in a well behind Kaduna State University (KASU), Kafanchan Campus, Jema'a Local Government Area of Kaduna state.

The man, as gathered by Daily Trust, was a suya seller in Kafanchan who was declared missing by his relatives penultimate Saturday, nine days before his body was discovered.

He was found inside a well in a farm belonging to one Malam Baba Kwasau who found the body when he went to clear his farm.

Aminu was suspected to have been abducted, killed and thrown into the Well.

The land owner, Malam Baba Kwasau, told Daily Trust that when he saw the dead body he immediately reported it to the kafanchan Police Area Command and Divisional Office, from where they sent their men for confirmation.

When this reporter visited the scene, the body was still in the well, but the Kaduna State Fire Service and SEMA removed it after he was identified by his senior brother, Abdullahi Sulaiman, through his fingers and the trouser he wore.

The acting District Head of Hayin Gada (Jema'a Emirate), where the incident happened, Alhaji Yakubu Isa Dokajen Jama'a, told Daily Trust at the scene that they had the report of two people missing, and now, one of them had been found dead. He asked the people not to take the law into their hands but to leave the case to the police to handle.

The Kaduna State Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Aliyu Usman, said at press time that he was yet to receive the report.
