Insurgents kill 5, injure 10 in Borno community

At least five people were killed and 10 wounded in coordinated attacks on Sunday when suspected Boko Haram insurgents invaded villages in Chibok Local Government Area of Borno State.

Civilian JTF and local hunters said yesterday that the incidents happened when insurgents rode on motorcycles to Tunyan and Komndi villages, some 15 kilometers away from Chibok town, abducting some women and looted foodstuffs.

One of the survivors, Musa Kadir, said the invaders stormed the two communities at the same time and many fled into bushes.

"Three people were killed, including an old woman and two others burnt completely beyond recognition. They looted our foodstuffs and livestock.

As I am speaking with you, five women are still missing," Musa said.
