Driver crushes 3 in Kaduna

A hit-and-run truck driver crushed three people over the weekend at Kujama in Chikun Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

A witness said the victims were all on a motorcycle when the heavy duty truck hit them, explaining, "I was in another vehicle when I saw the incident. The truck hit the bike carrying the victims and they all fell."

The witness said the driver appeared to have killed the victims intentionally, saying, "The most confusing part of it is that after hitting them, the driver turned around, came back and crushed them before zooming off."
