NSCDC operative nabbed over murder in Jigawa

A member of the Jigawa State
Command of the Nigeria
Security and Civil Defence
Corps (NSCDC), Jamilu Ali,
is being held by the Nigeria
Police over alleged murder
of a member of the National
Union of Road Transport
Workers (NURTW).

There was a clash last Saturday between members of the NURTW and Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), when vehicles belonging to the NURTW were impounded by the FRSC during an enforcement patrol on speed limit device.

The members of the NURTW marched to the command headquarters of the FRSC in protest over what they described as indiscriminate impounding of their vehicles but the protest turned violent when a team of the NSCDC

arrived the scene shooting in the air which led to the death of one Hussaini Andaza, a driver and member of NURTW while a policeman sustained gun injury in the chest.

The Jigawa State Police command PRO, SP Abdul Jinjiri told Daily Trust yesterday, "We have invited the murder suspect for questioning. The suspect has been in police custody since Monday."
