Youths protest killing of Maritime Academy graduate From Dickson S. Adama, Jos

undreds of youths in Zawan area of Jos South local government council of Plateau State have protested alleged killing of a Maritime Academy Oron graduate, Victor Henry Dokatrin, by operatives of the Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS).

The youths who protested on the streets of Zawan

during a condolence visit to the deceased family by the Chairman of Plateau State chapter of Police Community Relations Committee (PCRC) Major Chris Imoga (retired), along with the area commander and the divisional police officer Bukuruý, carried placards with different inscriptions.

Our correspondent gathered that Dokatrin, 34, who was also a grandson of former

speaker of the Plateau State House of Assembly, Hon. Patrick Dokatrin, was allegedly gunned down by SARS operatives in the area as he was returning from Barki Ladi local government area where he went to obtain indigeneship certificate form.

A family representative Chung Dokatrin who spoke on their behalf, said the SARS operatives who accosted their son summarily executed him

without any incriminating evidence on him.

'We demand total justice for our murdered son by SARS. We will leave no stone unturned to ensure that justice is done on this matter," he said.

Reacting, the PCRC Chairman said the Plateau State police command would ensure that the culprits among the SARS operatives were made to face the law of the land for the crime.
