Gunmen kill 2 in Fulani villages

Gunmen have attacked two Fulani villages and killed two people and rustled several cattle in Mambilla Plateau, Sardauna Local Government Area of Taraba State.

Daily Trust gathered that the gunmen, suspected to be Mambilla militia, attacked Leme, a Fulani village Tuesday night and killed one Alhaji Mogoggo, an 80-year-old man.

The attackers also injured several others and burnt down some houses in the village.

It was further gathered that another Fulani settlement in Tambaya also came under attack in the night in which one person was killed while several others were injured

The attackers also rustled several herds of cattle and abducted about seven people.

The state police Public Relations Officer, ASP David Misal, confirmed the incident but said normalcy had returned to the area.
