Many feared killed in fresh Mambilla attacks

Many people are feared killed in fresh attacks on Fulani settlements in Sardauna local government area of Taraba State.

Daily Trust gathered that the attackers were suspected to be Mambilla tribesmen and they sacked about 12 settlements around Yarimaro and Baruf areas on the Mambilla plateau killing several people.

The attackers, it was also gathered, have killed hundreds of cows and burnt down many X houses forcing residents to flee.

The cause of the attacks is yet to be known, but a resident of one the settlements attacked, Malam Garba Sule, told our reporter that the attackers in their hundreds and armed with dangerous weapons invaded the area at about 12 noon Thursday.

He said many people were killed

and houses burnt while property were looted and cows killed.

Malam Garba Sule said residents of the settlements have fled into the bush and mountains, adding that the attacks were still going on.

Contacted, the police public relation officer, Taraba State Police Command, ASP David Misal, said he will get in touch with Gembu Division on the matter, adding that he did not have details of the incident.
