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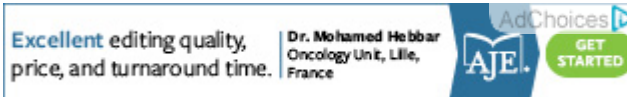
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At least three people were killed and 18 others injured when a suspected Boko Haram bomber attacked residents in Maiduguri last night.

The incidents occurred at Muna Dalhti area of Jere Local Government Area, Maiduguri at about 8pm.



Residents said a male teen detonated his Improvised Explosive Device (IED) in a crowded area, killing two civilians and injuring 18 people.

A resident, Mustapha Kale said the bomber targeted people gathered to buy bean cake and blew up self.

“The explosion happened at about 8pm, we lost two and 18 people mostly children and women sustained various degree of injuries because it happened near where they were buying bean cake.

“It is really unfortunate, we are indeed helpless, a little boy would come and just kill innocent people. Government should do something about it,” Kale said.

Another resident, Bukar Mahammud said many dead and the casualties figure may be higher because it happened near a tea shop.



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
