"We heard this morning that two policemen were shot dead by unknown gunmen. It was not during a shootout; in fact, there was no shootout. The gunmen just went straight and shot them.

"One of the policemen, who sustained serious injuries, was rushed to a nearby hospital. We don't know why policemen, who are doing their security job, should be targeted for murder," the source said.

When contacted, Rivers State Police Command spokesman, Nnamdi Omoni, confirmed the incident. He said the command has commenced investigation on the incident.






